The number of beneficiaries was above expectations. ▪ 33 students were supported in the Life Wide Learning Camp, 48 students were supported in the Enrichment Programme and 32 students were supported in ECAs. ▪ Due to changes in the learning atmosphere, the number of beneficiaries in the Tutorial Classes and Music Instrumental Classes was zero.
